# 1<sup>st</sup>

The businesses of GDF SUEZ and its subsidiaries cover the entire energy value chain (electricity, natural gas), from exploration and production to the sale of services.

The Group has a unique profile in the utilities sector, since it holds the 1<sup>st</sup> position in three key areas worldwide:

- liquefied natural gas (LNG), which is transported to consumers over long distances,
- independent power production (IPP), often combined with seawater desalination,
- energy and environmental efficiency services for public authorities and businesses.



200,000

**GDF SUEZ has 200,000 employees in close to 60 countries on all continents.**

Among them, 134,600 are specialists in the energy sector, including energy and environmental efficiency services, and 65,400 are devoted to environmental services (water, sanitation and waste management). Women represent 18.3% of the Group's employees worldwide.

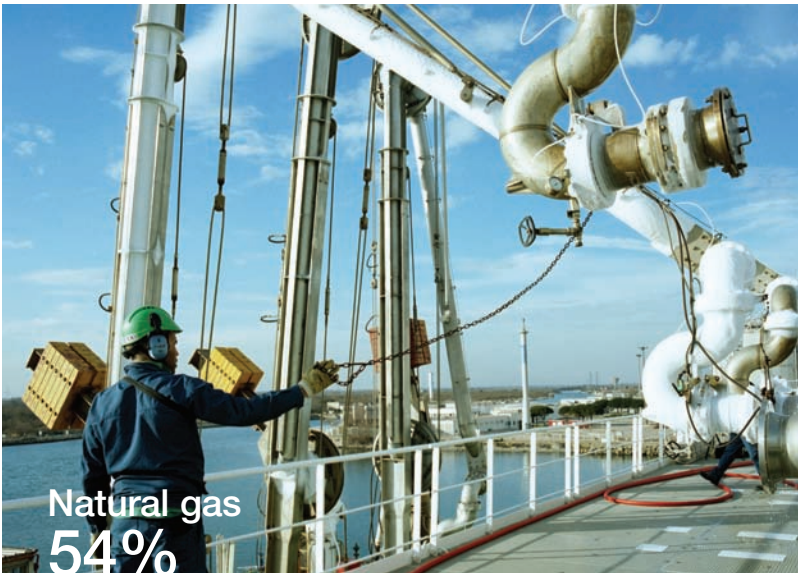
**Listed on the Paris, Brussels and Luxembourg stock exchanges, the Group has become one of the world's leading energy companies.**

GDF SUEZ achieved revenues of €83.1 billion in 2008. In April 2009, the financial magazine Forbes ranked the Group 17<sup>th</sup> in its Global 2000 listing of the world's largest companies and first in the utilities sector.

# 68.4 GW

GDF SUEZ relies on diversified supply sources as well as flexible and highly efficient power generation to supply reliable and competitive energy.

With total installed power of 68.4 gigawatts (billions of watts), its facilities are among the lowest greenhouse gas emitters in Europe. The Group's objective is to achieve 100 GW of electrical capacity worldwide by 2013 while maintaining a balance between all sources of production, including, for example, a 10% share for nuclear energy.



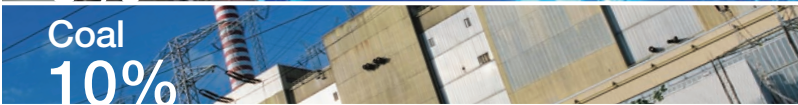

**The industrial vision of GDF SUEZ is based on developing renewable sources and optimizing the use of energy and natural resources.**

Renewable energy (hydroelectricity, wind power, biomass, solar power and biogas) represent 18.5% of the Group's installed capacity. These complement natural gas and nuclear power in the Group's production base as energy sources with minimal or no CO<sub>2</sub> emissions.

**To ensure the provision of natural gas to its customers, GDF SUEZ has diversified its sources of supply.**

The Group has a portfolio of more than 110 billion m<sup>3</sup> of natural gas per year coming from a dozen countries, mostly under long-term purchase contracts. Its own fossil-fuel reserves total 704 million barrels of oil equivalent (Mboe), allowing it to produce more than 50 Mboe per year, three quarters of which is natural gas.

**The Group's unique position in LNG is a key component of the safety and reliability of its energy supply to its customers.**

GDF SUEZ operates liquefaction plants and regasification terminals throughout the world and has many projects under way for new facilities. With the delivery of five new tankers in 2009/2010, its fleet of 20 LNG tankers represents a total capacity of more than 2.5 million m<sup>3</sup> of liquefied natural gas.

**Between 2008 and 2010, GDF SUEZ investments in maintenance and development will total €30 billion worldwide.**

The Group's sound financial position allows it to finance large-scale projects in order to strengthen its gas infrastructure and build new high-performance power plants. It is one of the solutions for responding to long-term growth in energy demand and environmental requirements from customers.

**The Group's research and innovation policy relies on the efforts of 1,200 researchers and experts throughout eight specialized centers.**

From eco-comfort solutions to water-treatment engineering, the analysis and complete grasp of energy and environmental challenges allows the Group's teams in the field to provide individuals, cities and businesses with solutions that are increasingly innovative and efficient.
